

Photo-documentation Protocol

Thank you for participating in our study. This document will provide you with instructions and some helpful tips on how to go about taking photographs of activities around teaching and learning at Karunya Mane. After we receive these photos from you, we would like to have a Skype call with you to discuss the photographs and your perspectives on teaching and learning there.

Please try to capture photographs of a variety of different types of activities related to teaching and learning. Try to capture a wide range of activities, such as, preparation, instruction, home work etc.

Some of the things to try and include are:

People: The people involved with the teaching and learning

Objects: The things used by the instructors and the students in the teaching and learning process.

Environments: The locations and settings in which teaching and learning happens.

Messages: The information being transferred between various parties involved in the teaching and learning activity

Services: People or systems that enable teaching and learning to take place

Note:

1. Many of your photographs may include information in more than 1 category. This is OK.
2. You may have more photographs in one category than another, this is OK too.

Remember:

1. Take many photographs and photograph often- there is no such thing as too many photographs.
2. Feel free to take photographs that go beyond the brief too. There might be other important aspects of the teaching and learning process that we have not considered that you know about from your experience with the children.
3. Capture natural photographs, nothing needs to be posed.
4. Please post the photos you collect to the dropbox folder whose link we have shared with you on a separate email.
